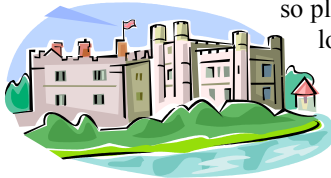
Member's Meeting January 2nd

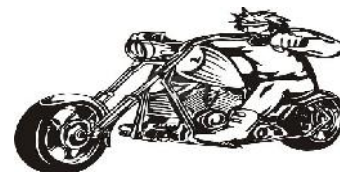
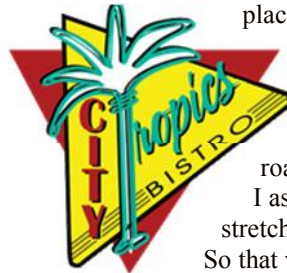
City Tropics Bistro January 28th
